CLEANING

- A. Clean the completed system, inside and out, promptly after installation, exercising care to avoid damage to coatings.
- B. Clean glass surfaces after installation complying with requirements contained in the "Glazing" sections for cleaning and maintenance. Remove excess glazing and sealant compounds, dirt and other substances from aluminum surfaces.
- C. Door opening assemblies shall be cleaned with general, non-abrasive cleaners suitable for painted surfaces; can be cleaned with soap and water. Wipe the surfaces with a soft, dry cloth per AAMA 609 & 610.
Note: Any cleaning solution with any amount of ammonia should NOT be used to clean the frames.
